### Herts economy shows strong signs of recovery

- Employment rate holding steady
- Unemployment at 4% comparatively low compared with pre-pandemic forecasts of 12%
- Long term annual growth forecasts predicted at 1.4%
- Wage rates in Hertfordshire remain comparatively high
- No visible signs of house prices depreciating

 Hertfordshire business base shrank in 2021, driven by low replacement rate (i.e. birth rate) rather than a spike in business closures

 But constrained by lack of growing on space and varying productivity levels
