- 6 new permanent tenant companies have joined since Jan 2021, 2 more joining in the summer
- We open for hot desking from 17th May with a strong pipeline of enquiries
- An increase in enquiries since February following the Government's new roadmap was released
- Organisations like our open spaces, our rural out of town location, free car parking, proximity to a town centre, onsite café, conference centre and scientific services, and collaboration opportunities with Rothamsted Research
- Organisations now giving greater consideration to importance of outside space and providing the right environment for employee health & well being
- We encourage a community feel in our office environment

• A safe environment – we're a Covid-secure venue




• A sustainable smart heating system, ideal for a comfortable working environment, and without the environmental impact of aircon
