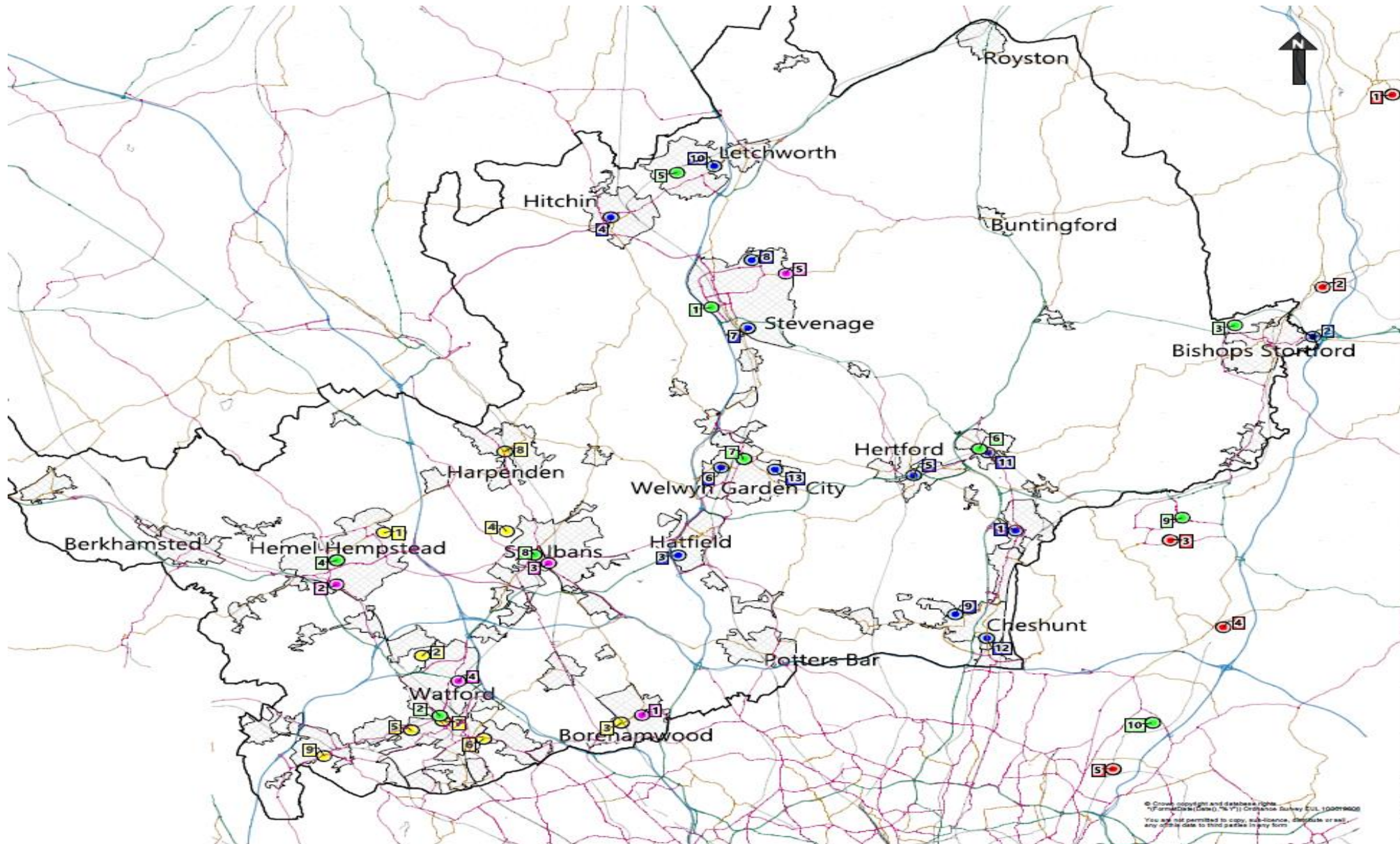

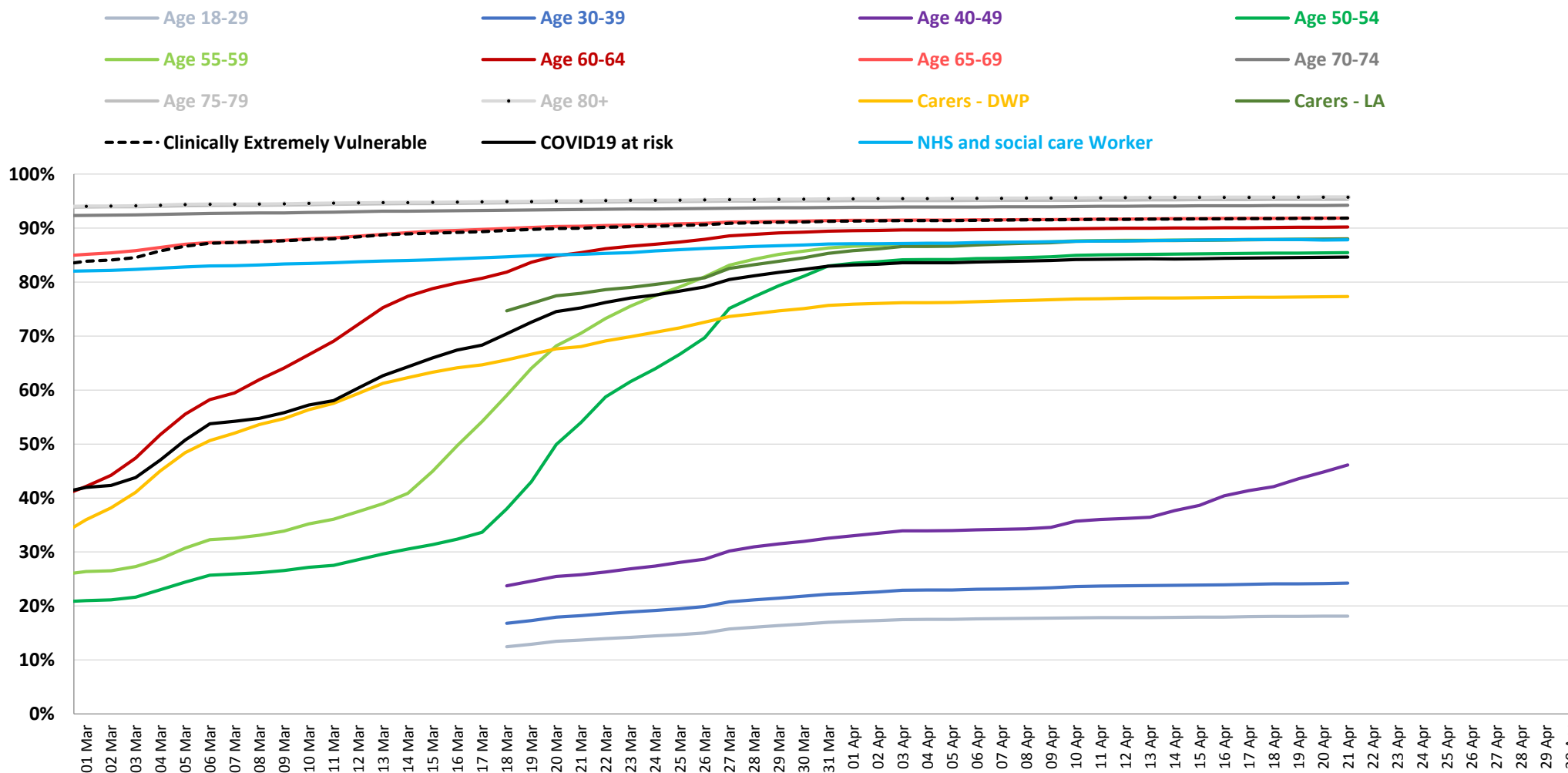

# HWE HEALTH INEQUALITIES

- Weekly meeting with partners to share resources, plans, ideas, delivery models and learning points. This includes behavioural change teams in HCC and ECC.
- A cross-sector communications and engagement plan is being developed in partnership with the ICS and voluntary sector. This includes briefing sessions for other public sector frontline workers who have day-to-day contact with, and are trusted by, many of the hard-to-reach groups.
- Active support to practices with reaching hard to risk groups and understanding barriers to vaccines from partner organisations e.g. PROVIDE, CLCH, HDET, EBIT and district councils

- Ethnic minority groups – a number of pop up sessions have been organised:
  - in Mosques for the Muslim population prior to Ramadan (Watford) where we have vaccinated over 600. Twilight sessions will be held for the next month.
  - further pop sessions for the Back AfroCarribean community are being held in Watford (tbc), Borehamwood (26<sup>th</sup> April) Stevenage (1<sup>st</sup> May) and Hitchin with support from the AfroGPs group
  - sessions for eastern Europeans are being held in Borehamwood (Catholic Church) and Stevenage.
- MSOA data is being used to target areas with low uptake - these are mainly the areas above
